Calon Lân'

Calon lân yn llawn daioni,
Tecach yw na'r lili dlos:
Dim ond calon lân all ganu -
Canu'r dyd a chanu'r nos.

The tune of the Welsh hymn 'Calon Lân', which is sung on religious occasions and at Welsh rugby internationals, was written by Daniel James of Treboeth and composed by John Hughes of Morriston in the 1890s. Daniel James was buried in Mynyddbach Chapel cemetery in 1920. John Hughes died suddenly in 1914 of brain haemorrhage aged 42, at 3 Stockwell Villas, off Mount Pleasant Hill. Colleagues from the Duffyn Works carried the coffin for his burial near his parent's grave in Caersalem Newydd Chapel, Treboth.

The English Translation of the hymn is:

I do not ask for a luxurious life,
the World's gold or its fine pearls,
I ask for a happy heart,
an honest heart, a pure heart.

The Welcome Inn is the second oldest public house in Swansea, the first being the Cross Keys in Swansea City Centre. The Welcome was built in 1582 and was a coaching house in the front and a blacksmith in the back and is situated on the old road to Carmarthen.
